

ARK First Aid Policy-September 2025

This First Aid Policy outlines the procedures and responsibilities for providing first aid at www.arkaep.co.uk. It ensures that all staff and learners are supported in the event of illness or injury.

Staff Training and Responsibilities

All staff at www.arkaep.co.uk are trained in first aid and are capable of responding to a variety of medical emergencies. The designated Lead First Aider is Allison Middlemas, who oversees the implementation of first aid procedures and ensures compliance with health and safety regulations.

Supporting Learners

We are committed to supporting all learners by providing a safe and responsive environment. Staff are trained to recognize signs of distress or injury and to respond promptly and appropriately. Learners are encouraged to report any health concerns to a staff member immediately.

Handling First Aid Incidents

Staff are trained to handle a variety of first aid incidents, including but not limited to:

- - Minor cuts and abrasions: Cleaned and dressed with sterile bandages.
- - Burns and scalds: Cooled with water and covered with appropriate dressings.
- Allergic reactions: Administer antihistamines or epinephrine auto-injectors as prescribed.
- - Fainting or dizziness: Ensure the person is lying down and monitor their condition.
- Head injuries: Monitor for signs of concussion and seek medical attention if necessary.

Administering Medications

Medications will only be administered by trained staff with prior verbal or written consent from a parent or guardian (if applicable). All medications must be clearly labeled and stored securely. A record of all administered medications will be maintained.

Policy Review

This policy will be reviewed annually or following any significant incident to ensure it remains effective and up to date.
